- Must have worked with data objects in Flex using remoting (FDS) or web services.
- Must have a solid understanding of UI design.
- Must have worked with an RDBMS system like MS SQL, MySQL, or Oracle.
- Must be well-versed in other aspects of web development like HTML, CSS, XHTML etc.
- Any of the following will be a plus:
 - Sample code demonstrating your skill in Flex.
 - Sample code demonstrating your skill in a language like Coldfusion, JSP, .NET etc.
 - A working application you can show us and explain in technical detail.
 - Experience with frameworks on either the server or Flex side (Fusebox, Cairngorm, Model-glue, Mach-II, Ruby Etc.)
 - Any experience with Object Oriented Programming
 - Other Technical Skills: Linux experience, server configuration, Hardware, Networking, DBA, familiarity with different database platforms, SDLC experience and the like.
